Continue master planning for site

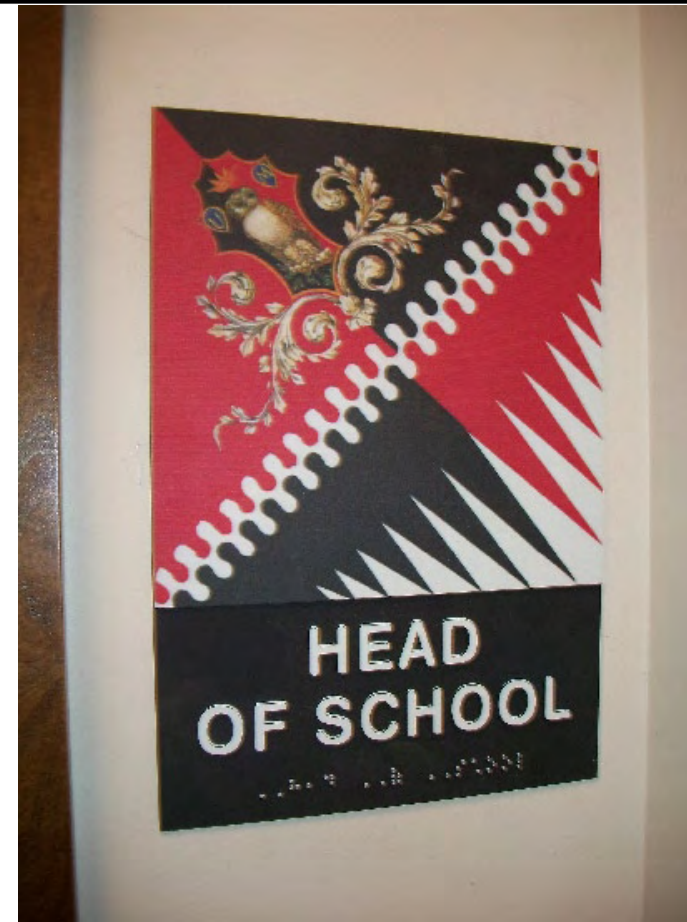

Improvements to include:

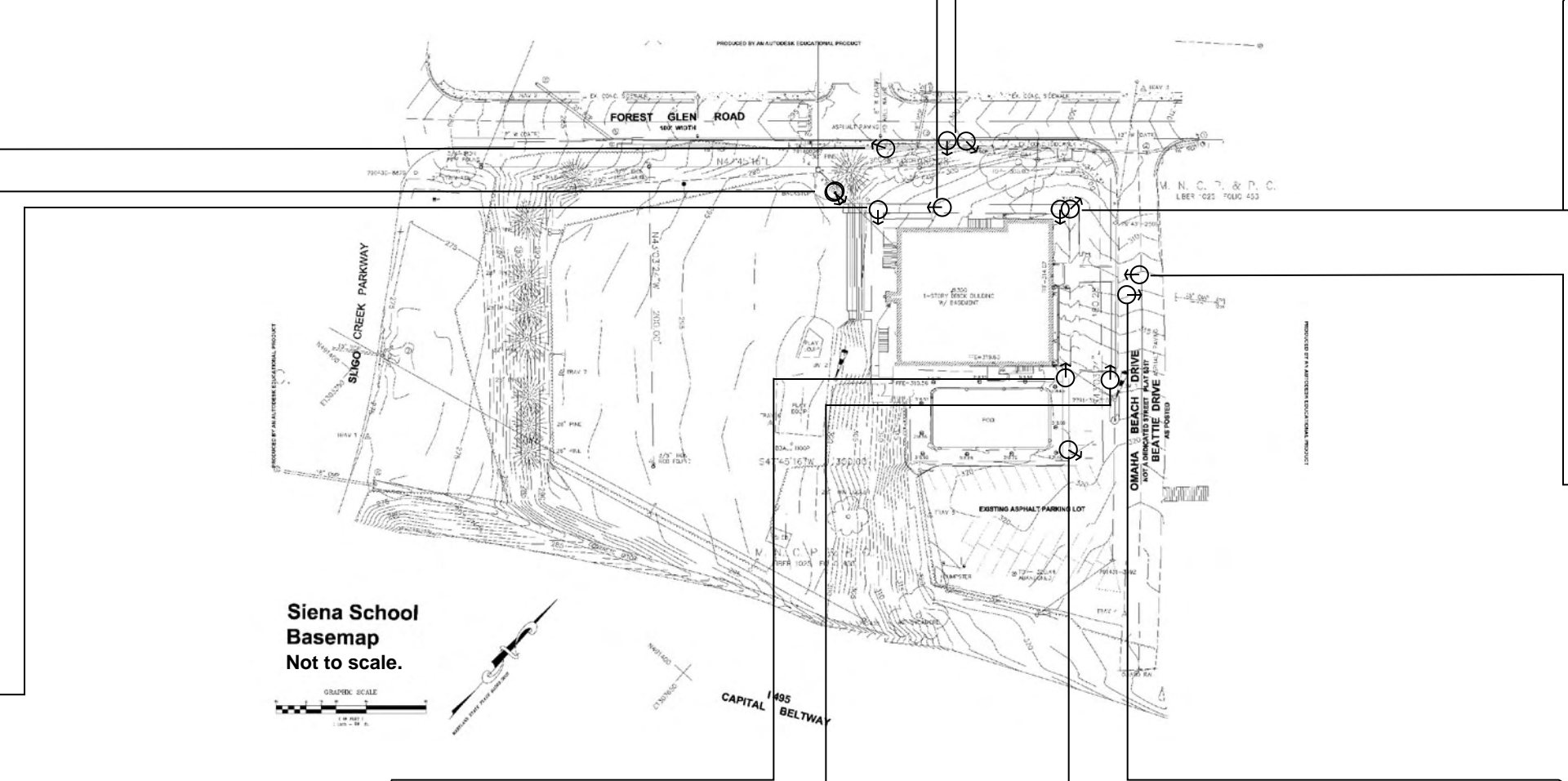
- Outdoor planters

Green team to focus on:

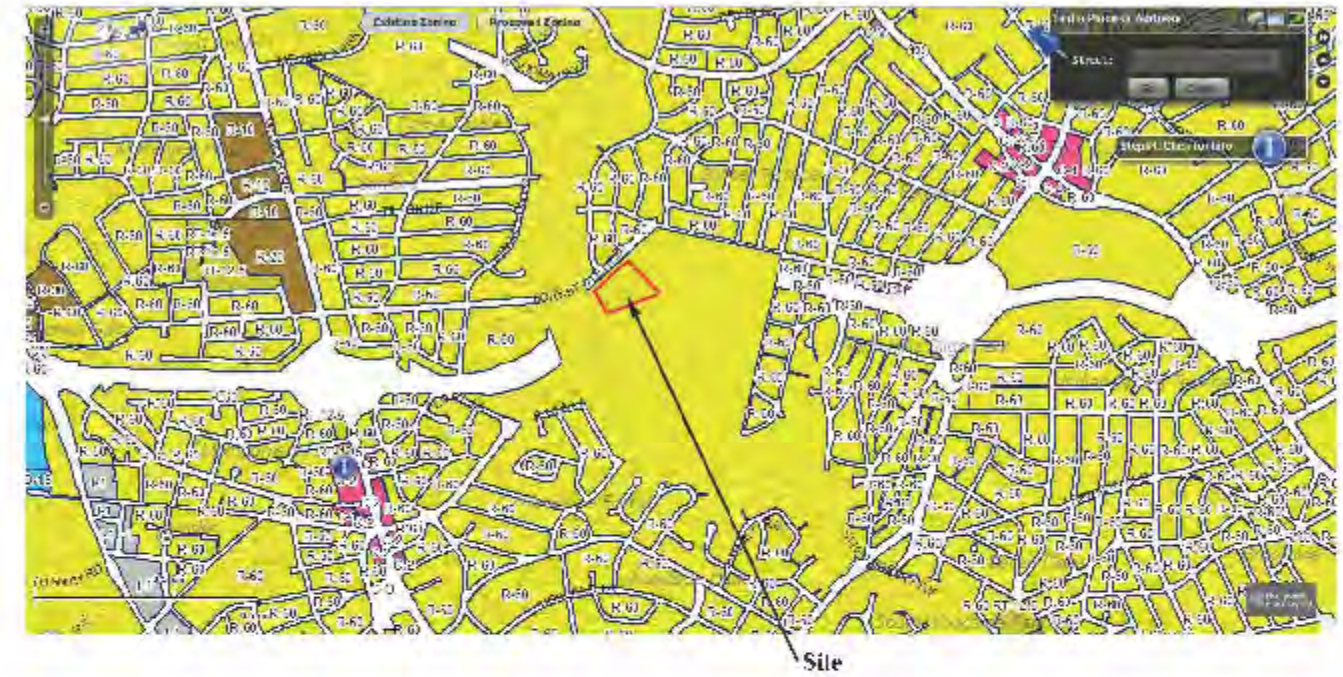
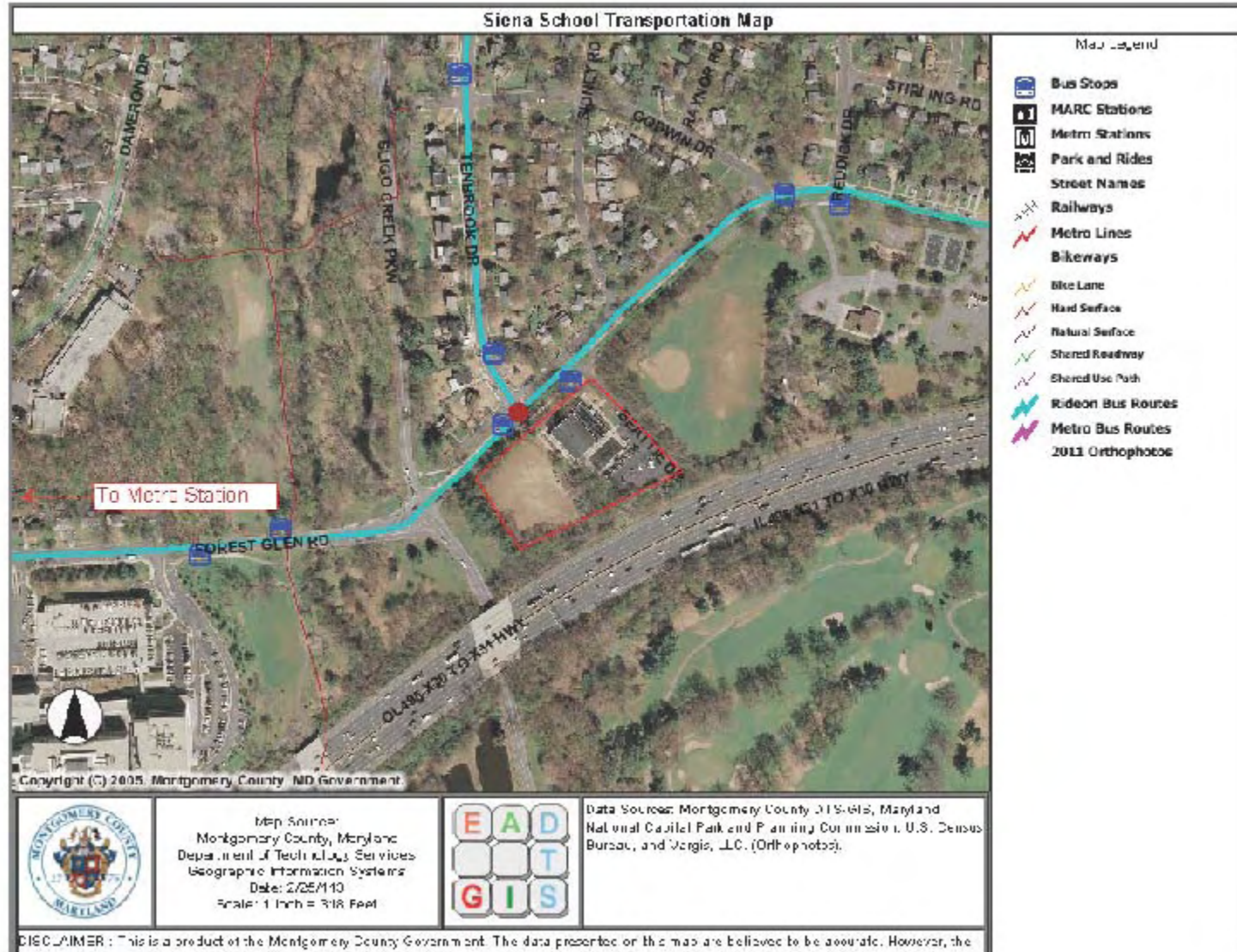

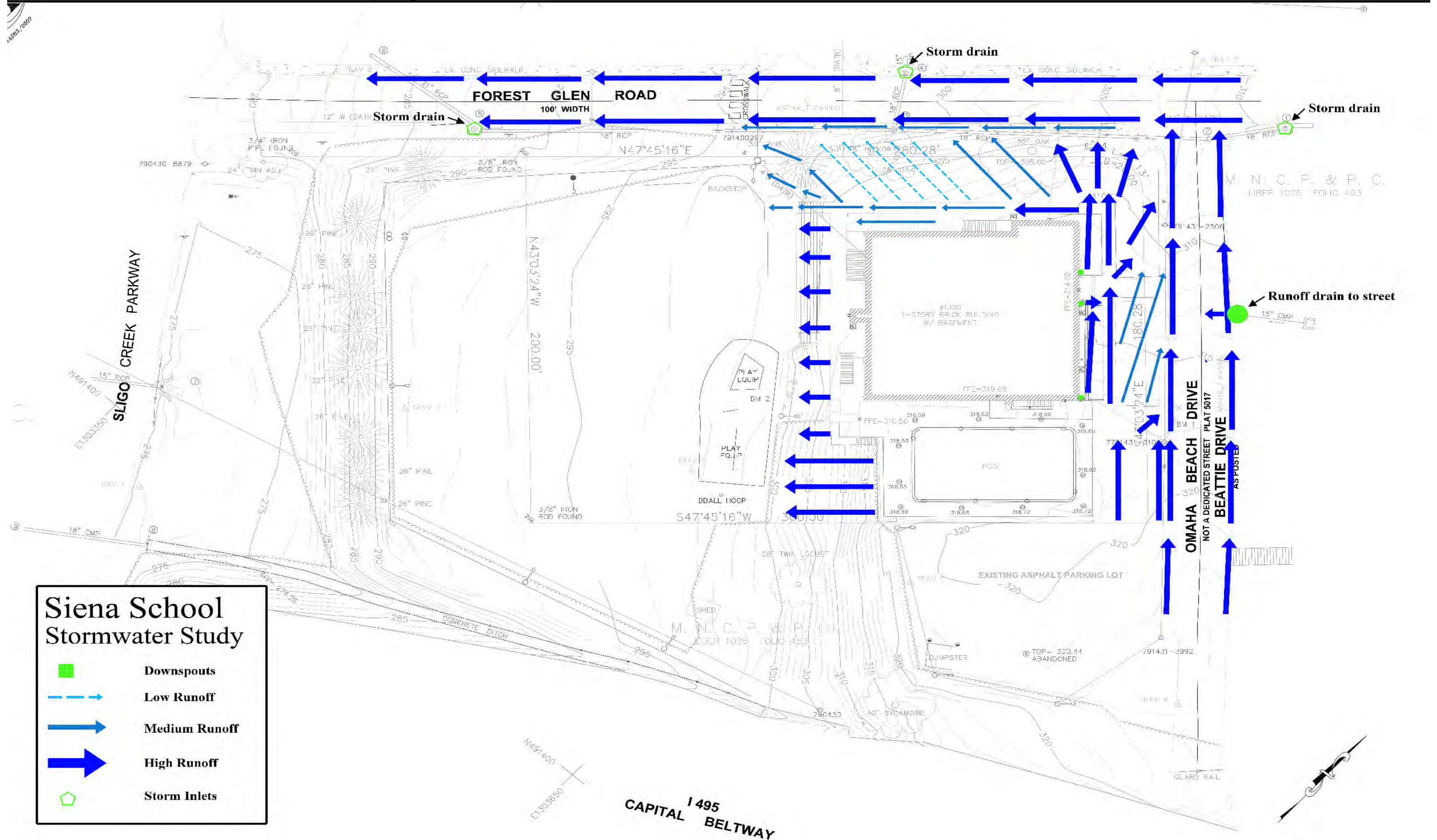


**Siena School Zoning Study**










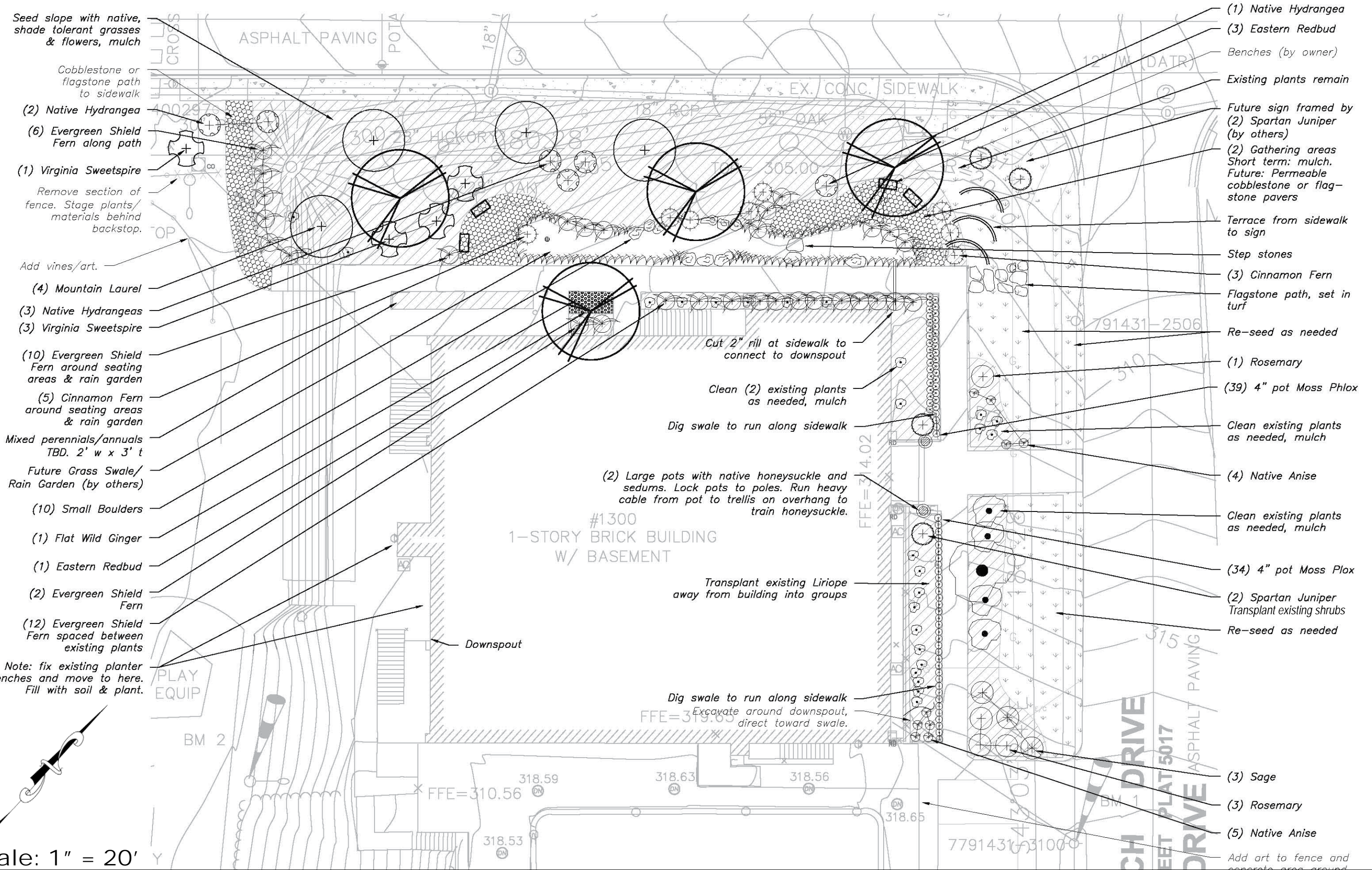

-  Storm Inlets









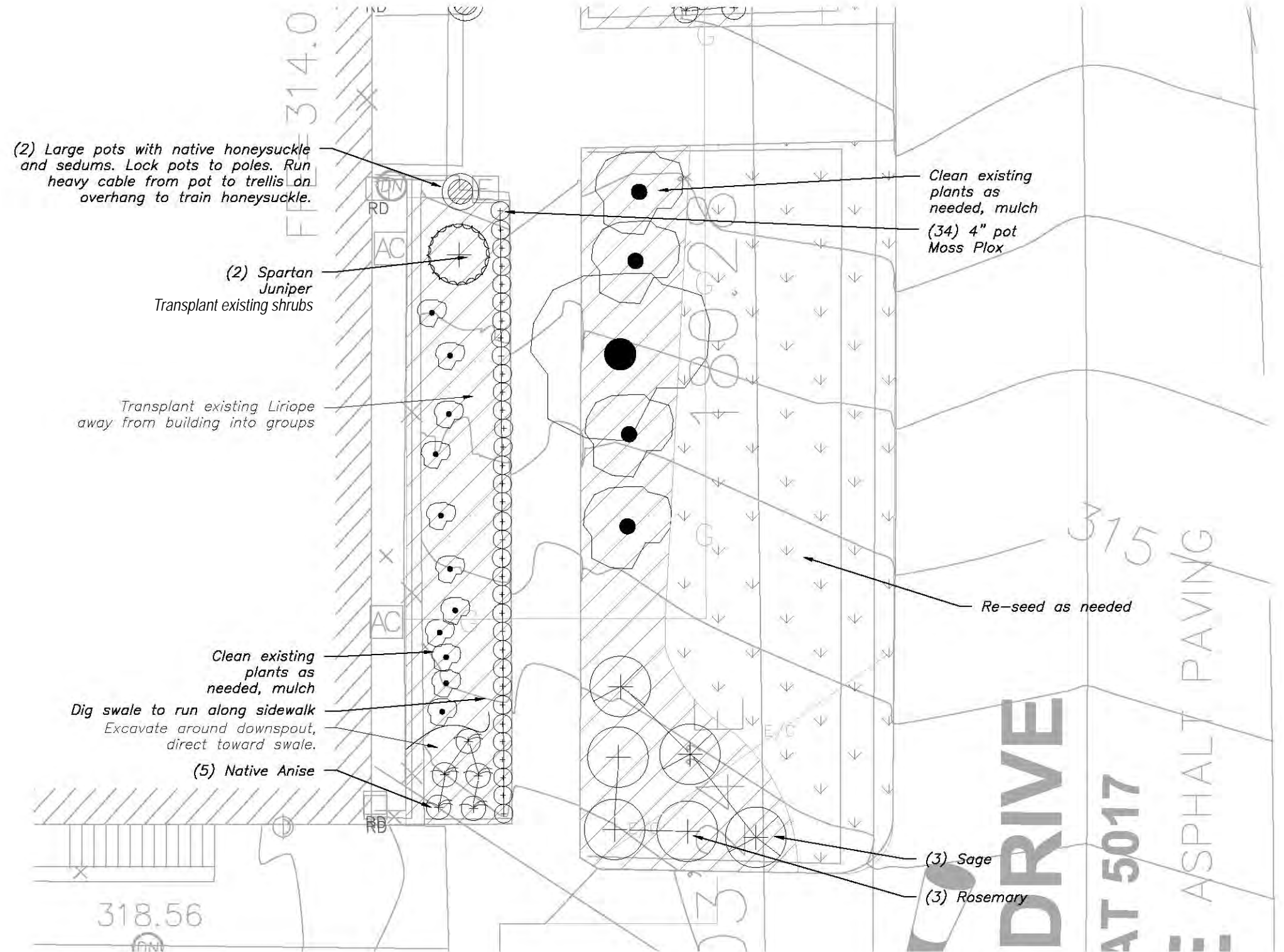
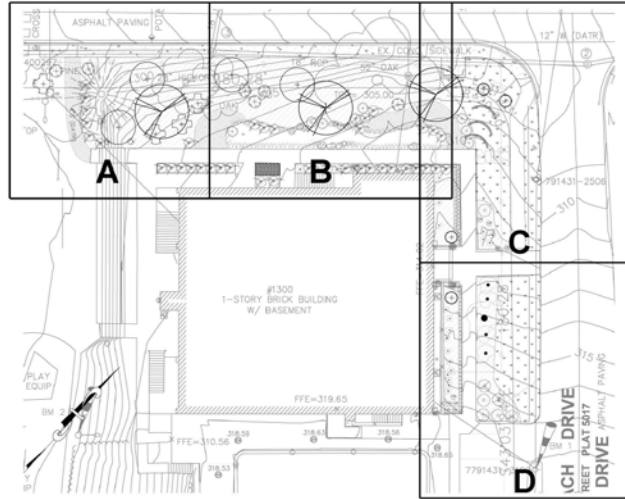












Area - D
